- 1. 2 full time elementary school counselor/therapists. One at each school started 2017-2018 school year. In transition for 21-22.
- 2. Brought in a full-time social worker at Edison started 2019-2020 school year. In transition for 21-22.
- 3. New Director of Student Services at Edison who is a licensed School Psychologist starting 18-19 school year.
- 4. Expanded summer school offerings to include Gifted and Talented enrichment classes. Over 200 students participated in 2019.
- 5. Pre-K program offered at both elementary schools. Started 2017-2018 school year.
- 6. Continuation of school Transportation.
- 7. Increased teacher pay to be competitive with surrounding school districts to attract quality teacher candidates and keep our highly qualified teachers 2017 to 2021
- 8. Restored the 6th grade athletic programs offering Football, Volleyball, Cross Country.
- 9. Upgraded our computer/technology infrastructure, increased internet bandwidth for faster internet
- 10. Added iPad and Chromebooks computers for student use in all schools. Now 1:1
- 11. Replaced and added new band instruments and equipment.
