Cut.

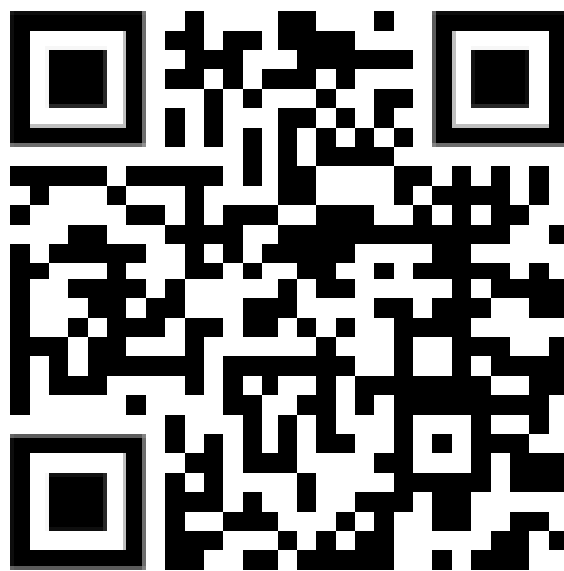
*Did they laugh?
