ACADEMICS



- National Awards & Recognition: Bailey was named Indiana State Distinguished School for Title I Services and was 1 of 6 Nationally recognized schools for Exceptional School Performance for Title I Services. Edison ranked higher than several Northwest Indiana high schools on the Best High Schools list by US News and World Report for 2019 and 2020.
- Graduation Rate: 2019 Edison graduation rate was higher than the state average
- **English as a Second Language:** ELL students meeting/exceeding growth targets rank higher than the state average
- Alternative Education Programs: Schedules at Edison can be adjusted to meet educational needs with the alternative program and partnership with Edmentum
- Kindergarten Preparedness: Annual program to prepare our youngest eagles
- **Title I Programs:** Title I Paras working in every K-5 classroom
- College & Career Prep: Edison offers courses to help students earn a year of college for free. In addition, Edison partners with Hammond Career Center and offers daily transportation. Historically Edison graduates collectively earn several thousand dollars in scholarships yearly. Over \$405,000 was earned by our 2020 graduates!

- **K-12 Project Lead the Way Program:** Provides K-12 students transformative learning experiences in science, technology engineering and math with real-world challenges
- **Partnership with Purdue University:** Education students work in our K-5 classrooms alongside our staff to bring our students enhanced hands-on science activities
- **Student Access to Technology:** Greatly <u>expanded Chromebook Program</u> in grades 3–12 and continued iPad program in grades K-2
- Google Classroom: Learning management system for grades 3-12 for digital lesson management, distribution and interaction
- Underwater Robotics: Edison team annually competes at Northeastern University, Illinois.
- **Field Trips:** Real-world experiences include trips to Challenger, Starbase, Argonne National Laboratory and more to connect to Indiana Academic Standards

- Academic Bowls: Bailey and Hamilton participate annually in the Spell Bowl, Science Bowl and Math Bowl and historically have several high ranking placements in the district and state competitions. Recently Hamilton Spell Bowl team earned 1st in their division and 4th place in the state for the 2019–2020 competition. Hamilton Science Bowl was in the top 10 for the state during 2020. Historically Bailey has also achieved top 10 status for academic bowls.

- Athletics: 6-12 grade program with +10 different sports. Recent championships include: Girls basketball 2020 Greater South Shore Conference Champions & Coach of the Year. Boys Basketball 2020 4-3 GSSC Conference Record, 3rd consecutive winning season, 2018 Greater South Shore Conference Champions. 3 semi-state wrestling qualifiers in 2020, and 5 qualifiers in 2019. 2020 Cheerleading 1st place finishers at LaPorte Slicer & Hobart Brickie Invitationals. 2019 7th & 8th Grade Volleyball Jr. Greater South Shore Conference Champions.
- **Music:** Edison offers jazz band, jazz combo, marching band, pep band, percussion ensemble, color guard, chamber ensembles, and a cappella choir. Annually attend ISSMA State Solo and Ensemble. 2019 ISSMA marching band percussion achievement award. Three time regional quarter finalists in the international a cappalla competition ICHSA.
- Art: 9 courses including up to date digital art with Digital Photography, Photoshop and Illustrator. Yearly student art show. Participation in community art including the CHAIRish The Children Art Project fundraiser and painting rain barrels for Earth Day.
- **Elementary Schools:** PE, Music, Library, and Art programs weekly for K-5 students.

- Safety, Social & Emotional Needs: Partnerships with several area agencies allow us to provide programs including Cyber Safety for Kids, Too Good for Drugs Awareness, Reclaim our Kids, and Child and Sex Abuse Awareness. A partnership with Innovations in Learning provides counselors in each school building. A Geminus partnership provides financial assistance, counseling and mentoring. In addition, the LSCS Director of Student Services is a licensed school psychologist who assists students with College and Career planning and helps to meet the social and emotional needs of the students and staff.
- **Preschool:** Partnership with Geminus Headstart to provide a preschool program at Bailey and Hamilton. The Bailey location also earned National Certification, which only 6% of preschools earn.
- Health Staff: Health professionals at all buildings and NorthShore clinic at Edison.
- **Educational Partnerships:** Partnership with Indiana University Northwest, Purdue University Northwest & Calumet College allows our highly qualified educators to mentor student teachers.
- Communication: We believe in constant communication between our school, our students and our families. Our software allows us to send emails, phone calls and/or text messages. We also utilize social media and our school website. Very soon we will even have our own Lake Station Community Schools App to help our families stay up to date!
