
Bailey 3rd, 4th & 5th Grade Eagles Choir

Car Riders and Walkers: Enter at Parking lot Door I at 7:40.

UNTIL 8:10. Students will be given a special *Choir Pass* to get into the building and can use their pass to go to the front of the breakfast line. They will eat in the Music Room.

Bus Riders: Although **not** required, students and the group will benefit from rehearsal time if they can be driven to school on Wednesdays for the 7:40 rehearsal. Bus riders will be allowed to go to the front of the breakfast line with their **Choir Pass** and eat in the Music Room while they rehearse. There will be a place for backpacks, etc. in the music room.

What is the commitment and expectations? Bailey Choir is a special performing group that functions similar to a sports team. Participation is vital for both individual growth and important for the success of the group. Choir students are expected to set an example for others by following school and music room rules and expectations* (see back of page).

<u>Rehearsal Attendance</u>: As members of a special performing group, Choir members are expected to attend before school practice to rehearse music. Members need to know the music in order to perform. Therefore, students are expected to attend rehearsals on time, and attendance will be taken. Excessive absences may result in suspension from a concert or performance until the next semester *unless* they are able to perform the songs for me at a specified time. *Quality rehearsals result in quality performances!*

Concerts: Concerts will be combined with the Hamilton Choir. There will be 2 concerts in the Edison Jr/.Sr. High Auditorium: a Winter and a Spring Concert. Students are expected to attend and perform at concerts. Students will be representing their school and are expected to conduct themselves professionally. *Concert Attire*: Dressy.
