The committee reviewed the entire dress code comparing it to surrounding school districts dress code. The finding were our dress code was similar and in some respects stricter. The obvious difference pertained to the wearing of hoodies. Our surrounding districts that permit hoodies are Hobart, Portage, Wheeler, River Forest, Eagle Park, Whiting, Hammond, and Merrillville. Our students would like to wear hoodies. The committee's concerns is whether our students can wear the hoodies in a responsible manner. The committee determined there should be a trial periods where students could wear hoodies under the following conditions. The hoodies:

- needed to be a solid color without words or phrases
- could be Edison Eagle Spirit wear, a college hoody, or one with a logo.
- had to be removed from the head and the hood worn down while the students were in the building.
- Student I.D. badges had to be worn outside the hoody.

The committee is still working, so they had no recommendations to present to the board. The committee will continue to do their work and consider the results of the trial period.



B. Board Q and A and Discussion:

Board members asked questions of the committee. The committee members that spoke said so far in the trial period students are being responsible. Hoodies are not a distraction to their education. The majority of students are wearing them and there has been no issues.

Board members asked questions of others that attended the meeting. The Director of School Security and the elementary principals expressed concerns. Their concerns were students could steal items and hide them in the hoody or bring inappropriate or dangerous items to school. Further good discussion took place between the board, the committee, and others who were present before the meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:30.
